Usage Guide

Unmarkable Textile and Rug Cleaner

The Warwick Textile and Rug Cleaner has been formulated using non-hygroscopic polymers requiring no additional water to trap and lift away stain causing elements. This process also ensures that no harsh rubbing or scrubbing is required that can cause permanent fibre degradation.

Areas & objects the spot cleaner can be used on

Couches, chairs, curtains, carpets, rugs, car seats. Anywhere there is an upholstery or fabric that meets the usage guidelines, the cleaner can be used.

The cleaner can also be used as a laundry pre-spray, once applied to the garment, the solution must be left to dry and cure before adding in to the normal washing cycle.

Pre-Test Before Use

HOW TO

Always test a small inconspicuous area before use. Apply the cleaner and let it rest for 5 minutes, use a white microfibre cloth to dab the area and check for colour transfer. If prominent transfer is present, cease use.

ALWAYS treat spills and stains as they occur

RUGS & CARPETS

Remove any solid soiling and gently vacuum to remove leftover loose particles, if it is a liquid spill, blot with paper towel or a white cloth. Apply enough spray to the soiled area to make it damp, but not soaked. Wait until the area is completely dry before vacuuming the encapsulated soils

UPHOLSTERY

Remove any solid soiling and gently vacuum to remove leftover loose particles, if it is a liquid spill, blot with paper towel or a white cloth. Spray the cleaner onto a white microfibre cloth then dab/press over the soiled area to transfer the solution. Wait until the area is completely dry then vacuum the encapsulated soils.

Repeat if necessary or seek the services of a professional cleaner if results are not adequate.

Blotting

Best practice for blotting is to lay an absorbent material such as paper towel over the top of the spill and let it soak up the liquid naturally, adjusting as needed until all immediate liquid has been reduced. Once this process has been followed, use a dry piece of paper towel and gently press to squeeze out any further liquid.

Tough Stains & Water Rings

If a stain is not coming out, further chemical treatment may be needed to reverse the damage caused by the spill, this is best done by a professional service.

Water rings may result from the fabric or textile containing preexisting dust and dirt that when mixed with the solution creates additional soiling. Water rings can also result from excess application of liquid, therefore it is best to apply lightly and repeat the process if needed.

WARNINGS
